

The exhibition is a showcase for the work of the architectural profession in the Greater Manchester region.

The awards, held annually since 1995, are presented for buildings that have made a particularly positive contribution to the local environment

How to enter Eligibility

Submissions are welcomed for students at Part 1 and Parts 2 levels.

Submission requirements

Final submission date: 12.00pm on Friday 26th May 2017

The entry must include the completed application form, a CD containing a PDF (A1 landscape at 300 dpi) of your exhibition board and a high resolution JPEG of a representative image of the project.

NOTE – Your entry will be printed / mounted by the MA.

Conditions of Entry

Eligibility

Students of architecture studying in the Greater Manchester area

In signing the entry form entrants are declaring that they are the author/s of the designs depicted. Where projects have been substantially co-authored this should be clearly stated on the display materials and, where appropriate, the permission of the collaborating parties should be obtained before submitting entries.

Submission Requirements

The entry must include the completed application form, a CD containing a PDF (A1 landscape at 300 dpi) of your exhibition board and the entry fee. Also provide an A4 size copy of the display board with the categories listed on the back.

Text should be in a Helvetica Regular or similar sans serif font and be of sufficient size to be read in an exhibition setting.

The content of each board submitted is at the discretion of entrants, but should include sufficient information to explain and describe the project design. Entries are not anonymous and the display boards should clearly display the name of the entrant and the title of the project. The Design Awards will be assessed solely on the basis of the display panels; the judges will not make site visits.

All Parts of the form to be filled in for this application to be valid.

Design Awards

Student award

The top 10 entries (in the view of the MA judges) will be printed for the week long exhibition, with the overall winner announced at the prize giving ceremony on 4th June at the people's history Museum.

Criteria for assessment

Entries will be assessed on the extent to which they demonstrate, in the opinion of the judges; fitness for purpose, elegance of design and the contribution they make to the built environment.

Selection of Judges

The judges will be selected from representatives of the media, the MA, architectural education, members of the cultural, art and design community and/or others at the invitation and discretion of the president of the Manchester Society of Architects.

Publicity

Details of the exhibition and the award winners will be circulated to the local press and to local and national professional trade journals. In submitting an entry all entrants are agreeing that any material they provide can be published by the MA and other third parties and that any images they have supplied have been cleared for publication by the copyright holder.

Closing date

Final submission date: 12.00pm on 26.05.17

Return of entries

Entry boards will not be returned by the MA. Models must be removed from 53Two (awards night) immediately after the event.
